



## CODE OF CONDUCT FOR THE BELGRADE REGATTA

We wrote some rules which we all should adhere so that all participants could have a good time on the Sava River during the Belgrade regatta. Since many people use the river and its banks, all must be aware that their behavior can endanger themselves and other participants of the regatta. Please have in mind the following things before, during and after the regatta:

1. Belgrade regatta is of the rowing and recreational character
2. All motor boats with registration are allowed to participate and captains of those vessels are required to have the appropriate license
3. All participants of the regatta must be registered with the regatta organizers, and all non-swimmers will be provided with adequate life-vests
4. Children under 15 years of age may participate in the regatta only in the presence of the parent / guardian.
5. All participants participate in the regatta at their own risk
6. All participants of the regatta are responsible for the damages caused to other persons or things during the regatta
7. All boats and people who are not registered with the regatta organizers are not considered to be participants in the regatta
8. All participants of the regatta must comply with the regatta captains and regatta officials who are specifically identified
9. The regatta will be run within the limits of 40m from the right bank of the Sava River, out of the international waterway
10. Consumption of alcohol is not recommended during the Regatta
11. Regatta officials will exclude from the regatta every person who is visibly drunk or violates these rules of conduct
